Facilities

The Campus :

The institute is situated at Bandhersole on NH-60 near Bakreswar Thermal power plant and between Suri and Dubrajpur. The well designed campus prevailed with green plants all around, creating a beautiful atmosphere.

Buildings and facilities in the campus:

Ragging

The institute strictly follows the guidelines of AICTE as far as anti-ragging concern. Regular meetings are held both by the anti-ragging committee and anti-ragging squad in order to monitor the standard of discipline both inside and outside the campus.



B.PHARM ADMISSION DETAILS

The applicants will have to qualify West Bengal Joint Entrance (WBJEE) or Joint Entrance Examination, JEE (Main). 90% of the entrants are absorbed from the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examination and 10% students are admitted from JEE (Main).

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must be a citizen of India and should have passed the H.S. (10+2) or its equivalent examination from a recognized Council/Board in a regular class mode with the following:

Age Restriction

Applicants shall at least be 17 years of age on 31st December in the year of admission. There is no upper age limit.

- 1) Individual pass marks in Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with Mathematics / Biotechnology / Biology.
- 2) Minimum of 45% marks in the above subjects taken together (40% for SC/ST/PWD/OBC) as well as pass in English with a minimum of 30% marks (for all categories of candidates) in the said qualifying examination of the Higher Secondary (10+2).
- 3) Applicant will be in good mental and physical health.
- 4) Candidate will have to qualify at the WBJEE, on the year of admission, or JEE (Main) for admission in B. Pharm Colleges.
- 5) Candidates will be required to submit a Migration certificate if he/she passes qualifying examinations from a board other than WBCHSE or a University other than MAKAUT. If the certificate is not submitted within the date specified by the University, the provisional admission of the candidate will stand automatically cancelled.
- 6) Residential/ Domicile Certificate required for Reserved Category candidates (SC/ ST/ PWD/ OBC) for admission in Pharmacy course. Refer to WBJEE website (www.wbjeeb.nic.in)

Lateral Entry

Admission through Lateral Entry to the 2nd year (3rd semester level) of the undergraduate degree course offered by Government / Private Pharmacy Colleges / Universities of the State of West Bengal during the Academic is open to candidates who have either passed diploma course in Pharmacy from any Polytechnic / Institute with at least overall 50% marks (45% for reserved category).



Candidate seeking admission in **Birbhum Pharmacy School** as per counseling under the supervision of West Bengal Joint Entrance Examination Board of admission in Bachelor of Pharmacy course are required to submit the Demand Draft drawn in favour of "**Birbhum Pharmacy School**" payable at "**Dubrajpur**". IMPORTANT RULES AND REGULATION

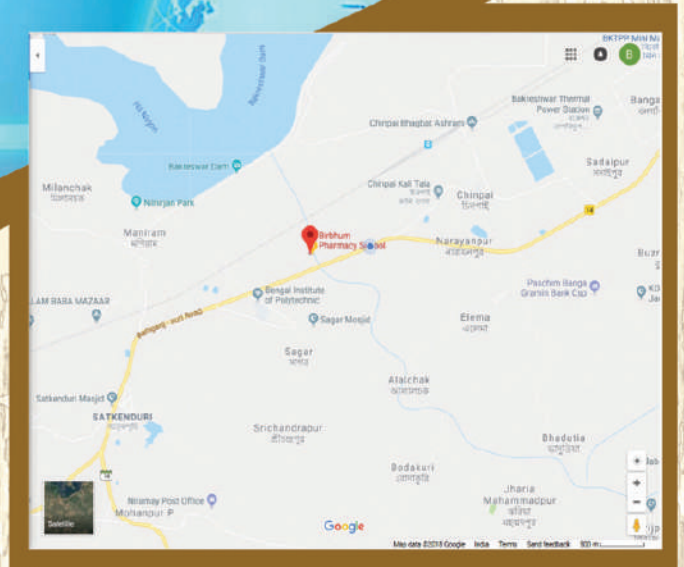
All candidates are required and expected to follow the code of conduct, rules & regulations as modified from time to time.

- 2) Any act of academic dishonesty, misconduct, indiscipline, violence by any student that causes any loss of property of BPS or any person of BPS will be considered as an offence against the institute and such student will be debarred from further studies at BPS.
- 3) The candidate must fulfill all academic requirements as stipulated by the institute from time to time.
- 4) Misleading information or misrepresented facts will disqualify the applicant from admission to BPS.
- 5) BPS reserves the right to amend the rules and regulations,
- 6) In case of discontinuation of course in between under any circumstances, the student will have to pay the Semester Fees.
- 7) Dress code is mandatory and a part of college discipline.
- 8) Candidates must bring the required documents in original for verification at the time of admission.
- 9) Students cannot undergo any other course in other institution during his study in BPS.
- 10) The ragging is strictly prohibited in the College and Hostel and as per law it is punishable offence with a fine and imprisonment, any student found guilty of ragging will be expelled from the College / Institute immediately.
- 11) Amount once paid towards admission is not refundable under any circumstances.
- 12) Students must participate in all programme organized by BPS viz. Republic Day, Independence Day, Annual Sports, Cultural Seminar, Social Activities etc.
- 13) Students must obey the rules & regulations of A.I.C.T.E., P.C.I. & M.A.K.A.U.T. & W.B.S.C.T.&V.E.&S.D.
- 14) Minimum class attendance of students should be 75%. Students having lesser attendance will not be allowed on avail any facilities provided by the institute. Students having more than 95% attendance will be awarded scholarships which will be sanctioned by the Board of Management.
- 15) Institute will help to provide assistance for interviews / written tests for placements which will strictly be on the merit of candidates. Institute will not be liable for selection of such candidates in the concerned companies.
